This information includes authorization to provide debtor's social security number to the creditor to verify that the details pertain to the exact case and/or claim, or if a creditor cannot apply funds disbursed by the trustee because an account number on the proof of claim is not complete or because the account number does not match the creditor's records or for other similar reasons.

HOW TO PROVIDE DOCUMENTS:

Your photo I.D. and proof of full social security number contain personally identifiable information. These documents are **NOT** accepted by email. If you are represented by an attorney, you must provide these documents to your attorney. If you do not have an attorney, instructions for how to provide your documents to the Trustee are attached.

DEBTORS:

You may access your Chapter 13 bankruptcy case online by visiting the National Data Center website at www.NDC.org.

Once you have entered the website, click on the "Get Started Now" button to begin the registration process. After you have registered, you may log in at any time to review your case's payments and disbursements.

If you have trouble registering for a Username and Password, you may contact the National Data Center by calling (866) 938-3639 Monday-Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Pacific Standard Time. you will need the following information ready when calling: your case number, name of the Chapter 13 Trustee assigned to your case, your social security number, your current email address and your Chapter 13 bankruptcy paperwork.

Please be advised that the National Data Center cannot discuss or interpret any of the data that is presented through this website. If you have questions or concerns once you have accessed your case, please contact your attorney.

The information presented through the National Data Center is updated nightly and the figures are accurate. However, final payoff figures must always be verified with your case administrator at the chapter 13 Trustee's office.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT INFORMATION RELATING TO
YOUR CHAPTER 13 BANKRUPTCY CASE WILL BE MADE
AVAILABLE ON THE INTERNET TO YOUR CREDITORS AND OTHER
PARTIES IN INTEREST.**

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C § 1 302(b)(1) and 7 04(7), your Chapter 13 Trustee has a duty unless otherwise ordered by the bankruptcy court, to furnish information concerning the administration of your bankruptcy case as is requested by parties in interest.

In furtherance of this duty, the Chapter 13 Trustee will make the following information available to parties in interest who request such information:

1. Your name, address, bankruptcy case number, state and district in which your case is pending and the trustee assigned to your case. Your social security number will not be visible to parties in interest, but they will be able to search for your bankruptcy case using your social security number. Furthermore, your employer's name will not be displayed.
2. Information regarding claims filed against your bankruptcy case including the identity of the claimant, they type of claim (e.g., priority taxes, secured, unsecured, ect.), and the amount of the claim
3. A history of all payments you make to the Chapter 13 Trustee in your bankruptcy case including the date and amount of each payment.
4. A history of all disbursements made by the trustee in your bankruptcy case including the date of disbursement, the payee, and the amount.

You may review, without charge, the information about your Chapter 13 bankruptcy case that is posted on the internet. If you believe the information about your bankruptcy case is inaccurate, you can contact the NDC to report the error and you should receive a written response from the NDC within thirty (30) days following receipt of such report.
